This bid guide is intended for UIPM member federations, sports or local authorities and entities wishing to submit a candidature to organise the UIPM Global Laser Run City Tour (GLRCT).

The UIPM UIPM Global Laser Run City Tour is an event organised during the regular season based on Laser Run, the combined shooting and running event invented by UIPM.

This dynamic competition is organised according to the UIPM values of respect and fair play and each GLRCT must be staged in a unique location that can promote sport, athleticism and culture.

Our UIPM UIPM Global Laser Run City Tour events are very friendly but passionate competitions. Each country can apply to host up to 5 GLRCT events per year, irrespective of participants' gender and abiding by the guidelines of UIPM. GLRCT is an event open to all ages which aims to bring competition and fun to urban communities as well as providing an entry point for young athletes at the base of Modern Pentathlon pyramid who want to progress in the other UIPM Sports.

The bidding candidates will receive full support from UIPM HQ and all UIPM Committees in preparation for and delivery of the UIPM UIPM Global Laser Run City Tour, ensuring that all involved stakeholders are fully satisfied.

The effective communication of the LOC towards the UIPM is one of the criteria during the GLRCT evaluation process regarding the equipment support.

EVENT BID

The above-mentioned organiser is bidding for **2025 Global Laser Run City Tour**.

Please note:

- This bid document is addressed to UIPM National Federations, their members (clubs, associations, entities), institutions and local authorities wishing to apply to host a GLRCT.
- All UIPM Rules and Guidelines are in forced at the time of the event will be applied. UIPM is providing the organisers **GLRCT Hosting Manual** and **Venue Dressing Guideline** with detailed instructions for the conduction of the event as well as **UIPM GLRCT Online Software Guidelines** for participants registration and results submission.
- Besides to return this bid document with signatures of the organiser, the bidder needs to provide relevant documents including letters of support from the local sports authority and the governing body as well as the plans and the pictures of the bidding location of the event that could enhance your candidature.

Timeline:

- The bidding application will be closed on 31th December 2024.
- All bid documents will be analysed by the UIPM and the UIPM will select the best bidding cities according to relevant criteria before 15th January 2025.
- The successful bids will be informed by the UIPM from 30th January 2025.
- GLRCT events must be organised between March 1st and December 31st 2025.
- For those successful bids, this bidding document will be conducted as hosting agreement and all the bidders would need to sign the declaration page within 5 working days after receiving the confirmation from the UIPM.
- The National Federations, their members (clubs, associations, entities), institutions and local authorities must pay the hosting fee(s) within 15 days of the confirmation from UIPM of the approved events.

02 UIPM GLRCT CATEGORIES FOR 2025

Each organiser can apply for GLRCT Categories "A" or "B" indistinguishably up to 5 events per country. For the country that has more than one organiser and apply for more than 5 GLRCT events, UIPM would select the best 5 qualified bidders and cities based on the submission of the bids also considering the conduction of previous GLRCT.

All events registration/entry fee from the participants will belong to the organiser respectively. All criteria are assessed for the GLRCT evaluation from UIPM.

Requirement of Category "A" GLRCT:

- 400 participants minimum per event with the results of all participants added to the UIPM GLRCT portal within 48 hours after the event.
- Premium location in an iconic place of the city.
- Full venue dressing according to the UIPM venue dressing guideline at Category "A".
- Impressive spectator/fan experience with professional DJ and commentator, certain entertaining program.
- Advanced Social Media promotion and active interaction with the UIPM Media Department. Photos and short article to be sent to the UIPM Office within 1 week after the event.
- Up to 25 Euro per person as entry fee (recommended).
- 1000 EUR hosting fee to be paid to UIPM.

Requirement of Category "B" GLRCT:

- 250 participants minimum per event with the results of all participants added to the UIPM GLRCT portal within 48 hours after the event.
- Facilities in an urban environment (downtown, stadiums, park and plaza, etc.)
- Standardised venue dressing according to the UIPM venue dressing guideline at Category "B".
- DJ and commentator involvement for the event.
- Social Media promotion and interaction with the UIPM Media Department. Photos and short article to be sent to the UIPM Office within 1 week after the event.
- Up to 15 Euro per person as entry fee (recommended).
- 500 EUR hosting fee to be paid to UIPM.

03 EQUIPMENT SUPPORT

You still have the choice between 4 possibilities regarding equipment:

- Obstacle training equipment kit (only for organizers that fully respect the bid and organise 3 or more GLRCTs & BTNTs)
- Pentasuits
- Shooting
- Fencing

Note:

- If several events are awarded to the same country, the supported equipment will be sent in 1 time to the address assigned by the National Federation.
- UIPM is entitled to cancel or suspend one or more upcoming GLRCT events (and its equipment support) that has been awarded to the organiser if the conduction of the previous event organised by the same organiser is not according to the standard and guidelines.
- The amount of supported equipment will depend on several factors such as the level of experience organising GLRCT events in the past, respect of the bid conditions, amount of equipment already received and ability to pay the hosting fees, etc...

04 EVENT FORMAT

- Shooting and running distances of the GLRCT are as below:

Age Group	Running Sequence	Total Distance	Distance to the targets
Under 9	2x300	600	3m (2 hands optional)
Under 11	2x300	600	3m (2 hands optional)
Under 13	3x300	900	5m
Under 15	4x300	1200	5m
Under 17	4x300	1200	5m
Under 19	5x300	1500	5m
Juniors	5x300	1500	5m
Seniors	5x300	1500	5m
Masters 40+	3x300	900	5m
Masters 50+	2x300	600	5m
Masters 60+	2x300	600	5m
Masters 70+	2x300	600	5m

Note:

- U19, Junior & Senior athletes will start to run 1 lap without shooting and then will run 4 laps of normal Laser Run (running /shooting).

06 ATHLETES REGISTRATION AND RESULTS

- Organisers will recruit the athletes/participants and register them according to the **UIPM GLRCT Online Software Guidelines**
- All the results of the events should be managed according to the **UIPM GLRCT Online Software Guidelines** and must be uploaded on the UIPM portal within 48 hours (this aspect will be highly considered for evaluation).
- Laser Run World Rankings will be created and permanently updated on the UIPM website. Athletes will earn points according to their ranking in each competition they take part.
- More detailed information is provided in the Hosting manual and GLRCT Online Software Guidelines.

07 UIPM REQUIREMENTS

The LOC will provide for all participants:

- Unlimited bottled mineral water on venue throughout the competition.
- If possible, some fruits and snacks for participants as supplement.

One ambulance on site is recommended

- On site medical care with resuscitation capability is recommended.
- General medical assistance must be available to all participants and spectators
- Sanitary facilities must be provided for athletes and participants on the FOP.

LOCs must send full media report including written articles, local coverage, web links of local media and pictures within 1 week after the event. The LOC is responsible to recruit a professional photographer for the event event (this aspect will be highly considered for evaluation).

07 FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

Considering the support that UIPM has committed since 2017 and which is still ongoing, UIPM will be charging a hosting fee of 1000 EUR for every category A approved event and 500 EUR for every category B approved event.
