Para Laser Run: 36+2 shooting range with precision laser targets (ALS)

300m lap tartan

Para Obstacle: U shape indoor

ACCOMMODATION

WARNING

Should a minor athlete be in need to share the hotel accommodation with another adult athlete (18+) or with an accompanying adult (e.g., Coach) it is required for such arrangement to be supported by the prior written consent of the parents/legal guardian of each of the minors. Providing the requested written consent is a must for checking in the competition hotel(s).

TRANSPORT

LOC guarantees transportation from the national airports of Vilnius and Kaunas and Bus station of Druskininkai to all the official hotels and the return journey on the arrival and departure days. Maximum waiting time in the airport is 1 hour.

Transportation from the Official Hotels to the Technical Meeting and the venues for delegations will be arranged according to the competition program.

SUSTAINABILITY

It will be the zero emission UIPM competition. All CO2 created by LOC to organize this competition will be counted after competition. According to previous competition data, Lithuanian Modern Pentathlon Federation community is planning to plant 1500 trees to neutralize CO2 produced by LOC of UIPM 2025 Para Tetrathlon and Pentathlon U19 World Championships.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

For delegations (athletes, coaches, officials, supporters) reserving the conditions accommodation package, the prices are as follows:

Single rooms are limited. Should you require wheelchair accessible accommodation, please include this information in your registration.

- This price includes full board accommodation, local transportation.
- Delegations wishing to arrange their own accommodation must pay an accreditation fee per participant (athlete, coach or official) to the LOC. The amount of the Accreditation fee is set at EUR 50 per day per person, a minimum payment of 3 days. For this, we will provide lunch for the competition days and allow access to official transportation between the competition hotel and competition sites.
- The check-out hour is 11.00 am. If the delegates will stay more time must pay additionally for accommodation and/or meals (1/2 day). Please inform the LOC about the extension of the extra day and extra meal.
- In the case of a bank transfer, the head of the delegation must have a confirmation of the transfer with him.

ATTENTION! All extra costs for bank transfers must be paid by the national federations. Otherwise, the amount will be invoiced afterward.

Paying cash upon arrival is only accepted if you have written approval from the LOC to do so and all financial conditions (costs) will be calculated on the prices mentioned above.

As a reminder, if on arrival for the competition, the team has fewer athletes and/or officials than listed on their Final Entry and without informing the LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will pay a fine to the Organizing Nation/LOC of 200 Euros for each person not attending.

At the same time as submitting the Final Entries all NFs must send to the LOC by electronic bank transfer or other means, 30% of the total amount of their accommodation invoice, otherwise their reservation will not be guaranteed.

DEADLINES

Delegations are kindly reminded that the UIPM Online registration system is obligatory. The online system will be open from 3 June 2025. All information must be submitted, including flight information, pistol serial numbers and accommodation bookings by 21 July 2025. Any changes after this must be sent by email to the organizer competition@pentathlon.lt

Following the closure of the registration system on 21 July 2025, an NF must enter the competition with at least one pentathlete/team per confirmed gender. Any failure to take part having sent their final entries will pay a fine of 600€ to the UIPM.





Deadlines are as follows

If we do not receive complete information about your delegation prior to the closure of the registration system or we do not receive your delegation's payment, confirmation then we will consider your delegation as non-participating.

ATHLETES LICENSES

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid UIPM Athletes Para License. Registration is not possible without a Para License Number. If an athlete does not have a license, they will not be allowed to take part in the competition.

For UIPM Para Tetrathlon World Championships the classes are restricted to PMP4 and PMP5.

Para athletes must also have a valid UIPM classification sports class status prior to competition, Classification opportunity will be offered on site but due to limited capacity Athletes/Teams are strongly encouraged to contact UIPM – Ms Radka Zapletalova para@ advance(moment of registration to event) Athletes must be competent at all disciplines.

INSURANCE

According to UIPM Rules, all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury and illness.

The organizer will not accept any financial liability or loss, injury or illness that occurred to any participant and or member of the delegation.

VISAS & VACCINATIONS

Visiting NFs should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into LITHUANIA prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All athletes are kindly requested to wear their official national uniform at the competition. Please also bring a track/record of your anthem and a national flag (120 x 80 cm).

Expected Weather conditions: The average maximum daytime temperature in Druskininkai in September lies at 23°C (73,4°F). The average minimum temperature goes down to around 12°C (53,6°F) (often the minimum temperature is noted at night). Rainfall during September is moderate with an average of 90,7 mm (3,57 inches). There are generally around 12 rainy days.
