The UIPM – Union Internationale de Pentathlon Moderne, together with the South African Modern Pentathlon Federation (SAMPA), has the pleasure of inviting a delegation of your country to participate in the **UIPM 2026 Para Tetrathlon World Championships** to be held in Durbanville, Cape Town, South Africa, from 29 September 2026 - 4 October 2026.

This competition will be running alongside the UIPM 2026 Masters World Championships

**If you require a UIPM classification for the eligible para classes, then please contact para@pentathlon.org before 1st July 2026. Eligibility will need to be granted prior to an in person classification at the event. We would advise classification at the soonest possible point.*

COMPETITION FORMAT/ RULES

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules and Regulations.

Swimming:	25m Indoor pool
Laser Run:	36+2 shooting range with laser targets (EcoAims LTS600)
Running Course:	Grass surface
Obstacle:	outdoor, straight-line, grass surface, official UIPM Youth course and rules for the course applies, bar and rope on the finish wall

Notes

- Sports classes will follow the Para UIPM Tetrathlon Guidelines.
- Unlimited number of individuals can register with a valid UIPM ID number and Sports Class.
- Minimum age is 12 years old on competition day. This is an open age competition.
- Para sports classes eligible includes PMP2, PMP4, PMP5, PM7b.
- Para Tetrathlon format: Swimming, Obstacle, Laser Run.
- Para format: 100m swimming, 70m Obstacle (4x5m Shooting, 300m Laser Run).

- Relay events will follow an inter-country relay format, allowing athletes from different countries to compete together in relay teams at no additional cost. Further details and team arrangements will be explained during the Technical Meeting.

WELCOME DINNER

All athletes, coaches, officials and supporters are invited to a welcome dinner on the terrace at the Durbanville Protea Hotel on the evening of Wednesday 30 September 2026 from 18:00.

The cost of the welcome dinner is included in the accreditation fee. Delegates that are not accredited are welcome to attend the welcome dinner at a cost of 25€ per person.

CLOSING CEREMONY

All athletes, coaches, officials and supporters are invited to a welcome dinner on the terrace at the Durbanville Protea Hotel on the evening of Saturday 3 October 2026.

The cost of the closing ceremony is included in the accreditation fee. Delegates that are not accredited are welcome to attend the closing ceremony at a cost of 40€ per person.

ACCOMMODATION

Participants will be accommodated at the Protea Hotel Durbanville and Tygervalley respectively (3* hotels). The Technical Meeting will be at Fairmont High School, Durbanville and the LOC Office will also be located at the Fairmont High School. Rooms are reserved on a first registered first served basis.

TRANSPORT

Transportation is included in the accommodation package and Includes transfers to and from the competition venue.

Transportation from the Official Hotels to the competition venue for delegations will be arranged according to the competition program.

ENTRY LINK

Athletes are kindly requested to complete the online entry form by selecting the disciplines in which they wish to participate. Once your entry has been submitted, an invoice will automatically be generated and sent to you via email from the online portal. Please ensure that all selected activities are correct before submission, as these will form the basis of your registration and billing. The entry link will follow shortly.

MERCHANDISE

There will be no additional merchandise available to buy during the competition.

- Limited rooms are available at the competition hotels; therefore, we recommend that you register for the event as soon as possible to increase your chances of securing a room at the competition hotels.
- This price includes full board accommodation and local transportation (from the competition hotel, including airport transfers).
- Check-in is at 14:00 and check-out hour is 10.00 am. If the delegates wish to stay for a longer period, they will be required to pay additionally for accommodation and/or meals (½ day). Please inform the LOC about the extension of the extra day and extra meal.
- Please follow the payment link for payment of entry fees (link is available upon request from the LOC).

DEADLINES

Delegations are kindly reminded that registration will take place via an online link provided by SAMPA. The online system will be open **from 21 April 2026**. All information must be submitted, including flight information, pistol serial numbers and accommodation bookings by 15 Aug 2026.

If complete information about your delegation or payment confirmation is not received prior to the closure of the registration system, your delegation will be considered as non-participating.

ATHLETES LICENSES

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they have a valid Athletes License. Registration is not possible without a License Number. If an athlete does not have a license, they will not be allowed to take part in the competition. You are reminded of Rule 1.12.1 i).

INSURANCE

According to UIPM Rules, all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury and illness.

The organizer will not accept any financial liability or loss, injury or illness that occurred to any participant and or member of the delegation.

VISAS & VACCINATIONS

Visiting NFs should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into South Africa prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All Participant "athletes, coach or team doctor" are kindly requested to wear their official national uniform at the competition. Please also bring a track/recording of your anthem and a national flag (120 x 80 cm).

Expected Weather conditions: The average maximum daytime temperature in Cape Town in Sept/Oct lies at 22°C (71,6°F). The average minimum temperature goes down to around 11°C (51.8°F) (often the minimum temperature is noted at night).

Voltage: 220 V

LASER PISTOLS/SIMULATORS

The use of laser pistols/simulators are permitted in South Africa, with no specific licensing conditions.

The South African Modern Pentathlon Association is in the process of consulting with the Airports Company of South Africa to provide delegations with detailed guidance on the procedures for arrivals and departures procedures at the competition airports Cape Town International Airport. For delegates transferring via another South African airport, please ensure that you confirm carriage of your laser pistol/simulator with the particular airline as their rules and regulations differ.
